ORDER TO ADMIT EVIDENCE CONCERNING WITNESS CEDRIC THORNBERRY

TRIAL CHAMBER III ("Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

CONSIDERING that at the hearing of 17 January 2008, the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") requested the admission of eight exhibits¹, whereas Counsel for the Accused Stojić ("Stojić Defence"), Counsel for the Accused Praljak ("Praljak Defence") and Counsel for the Accused Petković ("Petković Defence") requested, respectively, the admission of 2², 9³ and 7⁴ exhibits concerning the testimony of Cedric Thornberry ("Proposed Exhibits")⁵ who appeared from 14 to 16 January 2008,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber has heard the Prosecution objections to the admission of the Proposed Exhibits⁶,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber has examined each of the Proposed Exhibits based on the admission criteria defined in its Decision on Admission of Evidence of 13 July 2006 ("Decision of 13 July 2006"),

CONSIDERING that the Chamber decides to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits marked as "Admitted" in the Annex attached to this Decision because they were presented to Witness Cedric Thronberry and present sufficient indicia of relevance, probative value and reliability,

CONSIDERING that the Chamber decides not to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits marked "Not admitted" in the Annex attached to this Decision, because they do not comply with the instructions in the Decision of 13 July,

FOR THE FOREGOING REASONS,

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

PARTLY GRANTS the requests for admission filed by the Prosecution, the Stojić Defence, the Praljak Defence and the Petković Defence,

DECIDES to admit into evidence the Proposed Exhibits marked "Admitted" or "Admitted in part" in the Annex attached to this Decision,

DECIDES to reject Exhibit P 04395 which was requested by the Stojić Defence for the reasons set out in the Annex attached to this Decision, **AND**

DECIDES by a majority of the Trial Chamber Judges to deny in all other requests the requests for admission by the Prosecution, the Praljak Defence and the Petković Defence for the reasons set out in the Annex attached to this Decision.
