THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Appeals Chamber" and "International Tribunal", respectively),

**NOTING** the Judgement rendered in this case by Trial Chamber II on 31 January 2005;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the Appeals Chamber's decision of 7 June 2007<sup>2</sup> reopening the respective appeals of Pavle Strugar and the Prosecution against the Trial Judgement;

**NOTING** that Rule 114 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules") provides that "[a]fter the expiry of the time-limits for filing the briefs provided for in Rules 111, 112 and 113, the Appeals Chamber shall set the date for the hearing and the Registrar shall notify the parties";

**CONSIDERING** that the briefing on appeal in this case is complete;<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** that there are no pending motions in this case;

**HEREBY ORDERS** that the Appeals shall be heard on Wednesday, 23 April, 2008 at 09:30 ("Appeals Hearing");

**CONSIDERING** the need to ensure that the time allotted for the Appeals Hearing is used as efficiently as possible;

**HEREBY INFORMS** the parties that, subject to adjustments where appropriate, the timetable for the Appeals Hearing in the present case shall be as follows:<sup>4</sup>
