I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING the "Order Designating the State in which Duško Sikirica is to Serve his Prison

Sentence," signed on 25 January 2002, in which the President of the International Tribunal

designates Austria as the State in which Duško Sikirica is to serve his sentence on a confidential

and ex parte basis ("Order");
