THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of "Vladimir Lazarević's Eight Motion

to Amend Rule 65ter Exhibit List," filed 29 January 2008, and "Vladimir Lazarević's Ninth Motion

to Amend Rule 65ter Exhibit List," filed 30 January 2008 ("Motions"), and hereby issues this

decision thereon.

1. In the Motions, the Lazarević Defence seeks to add documents to its Rule 65 ter exhibit list<sup>1</sup>

on the bases that they (a) were unintentionally omitted from the initial exhibit list, (b) were recently

disclosed by the Prosecution on 7 January 2008, (c) were recently received from the National

Council for Cooperation with the Tribunal, or (d) were recently provided by the witnesses Radojko

Stefanović and Aleksandar Petković during their proofing. The Lazarević Defence argues that the

documents are relevant to the trial and indispensable for the presentation of the defence case and

that their addition to the list would serve the interests of justice.

2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to oppose the Motions.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 65 ter of the Rules of Procedure

and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motions.
