THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of the "Lazarevic Defence Motion Regarding the Exhibit 5D1290," filed on 11 February 2008 ("Motion"), and hereby issues this order thereon.

1. On 12 November 2007, exhibit 5D1290—Report on the Work of the Military Court and the Priština Corps Command—was admitted into evidence. In the Motion, the Lazarević Defence informs the Trial Chamber that the original B/C/S version of the document was erroneously scanned into eCourt so that the last three sentences were missing, and additionally that a properly scanned version of the exhibit has been uploaded to eCourt. The Lazarević Defence requests that the revised original of exhibit 5D1290 be admitted into evidence.

2. The Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to respond to the Motion.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion and ORDERS that the revised original of exhibit 5D1290 be admitted into evidence.
