I, FAUSTO POCAR, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING the "Order Designating the State in which Biljana Plavšić is to Serve her Sentence", of

24 April 2003, in which the President of the International Tribunal designates Sweden as the State

in which Biljana Plavšić is to serve her sentence ("Order");

CONSIDERING that Biljana Plavšić has already been transferred to Sweden;

FINDING therefore that the reason for issuing the Order on a confidential basis is no longer

applicable;

HEREBY INSTRUCT the Registry of the International Tribunal to lift the confidential status of

the Order, and **ORDER** that the Order shall henceforth be considered a public filing.
