I, **Judge Bakone Justice Moloto**, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING SEISED OF the “Motion to Request Extension of Time for Reply to Defence Response to Prosecution Motion to File a Fourth Supplemental Rule 65 *ter* Exhibit List”, filed on 17 April 2008 (“Motion”), wherein the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) requests the Chamber an extension of time to file its reply to the Defence Response to Prosecution Motion to File a Supplemental Rule 65 *ter* Exhibit List With Annex A (“Response”);

NOTING that the Prosecution requests that it be granted an extension of time to file its reply to the Response no later than 9 May 2008;

NOTING that Rule 127 (A) of the Rules provides that a Trial Chamber, on good cause being shown by Motion, may extend or reduce any time prescribed by or under these rules;


NOTING the arguments provided by the Prosecution in the Motion;
