

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) is seized of the “Joint Request to Replace Translation of P855,” filed on 16 April 2008 (“Motion”), and hereby renders this order thereon.

1. In the Motion, the parties inform the Chamber that the preamble to the Constitution of the Republic of Serbia—P855—was missing from the translation in eCourt and request leave to replace the old translation with a newly-corrected one, which includes the preamble.

2. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby GRANTS the Motion and ORDERS that the revised translation of P855 shall replace the previous translation in eCourt, and shall be admitted into evidence.
