NOTING that the Defence has closed its case on Monday 21 April 2008;


CONSIDERING that it is therefore appropriate for the Trial Chamber to now provide notice to the Prosecution and Defence ("Parties") on its anticipated schedule for case completion;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54, 86, 126*bis* and 127 of the Rules

HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

1. Both Parties shall file their final trial briefs no later than Friday 30 May 2008.
2. The Prosecution shall present its closing argument on Monday 9 June 2008 and the Defence shall present its closing argument on Tuesday 10 June 2008. Both Parties will be given three (3) hours for their presentation which should be limited to arguments in response to those of the other side's final trial brief.
3. Wednesday 11 June 2008 will be reserved for the presentation of arguments in rebuttal and rejoinder, if the Parties so desire, and for questions asked by the Judges.
