
NOTING the oral order concerning the admission of certain exhibits, rendered on 21 April 2008 (“Oral Order”),

NOTING that the disposition of the Oral Order was read out as follows: “The Trial Chamber holds that exhibits 1316, 1317, 1375 and 1376 shall [be] expunged from the trial record”;¹

CONSIDERING that Judge Harhoff dissented from the Oral Order;

HEREBY ORDERS that the disposition of the Oral Order should instead read: “The Trial Chamber **by majority, Judge Harhoff dissenting**, holds that exhibits 1316, 1317, 1375 and 1376 shall be expunged from the trial record.”
