**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal") is seised of the "Sreten Lukic Request Regarding Exhibit 6D 612," filed on 1 May 2008 ("Motion"), and hereby issues this order thereon.

1. On 12 March 2008, exhibit 6D612, entitled "SUP Prizren, Case Pusto Selo", was marked for identification pending translation. Because of the large number of pages of the original B/C/S document, the Lukić Defence decided to request that only the following pages of the original document be translated: 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 21, and 23. In the Motion, the Lukić Defence informs the Chamber and the parties that the translation of these pages of exhibit 6D612 is now available and has been uploaded to eCourt. Further, the Lukić Defence requests that the exhibit and its translation be admitted into evidence. The Chamber, however, considers that it would be inappropriate to have those portions of the original B/C/S document that have not been translated on the official record of the proceedings.

2. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 54 and 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, ORDERS that the Lukić Defence shall upload to eCourt, within seven days of the date of this Order, a new B/C/S version of exhibit 6D612, including only those portions corresponding to the pages that have been translated, and then notify the Chamber and the parties via a written filing.
