**I, FAUSTO POCAR**, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

**NOTING** the “Order Designating the State in which Haradin Bala is to Serve his Prison Sentence,” filed on 7 February 2008, in which the President of the International Tribunal designates France as the State in which Haradin Bala is to serve his sentence (“Order”);

**CONSIDERING** that Haradin Bala has already been transferred to France;

**FINDING** therefore that the reason for issuing the Order on a confidential basis is no longer applicable;

**HEREBY INSTRUCT** the Registry of the International Tribunal to lift the confidential status of the Order, and **ORDER** that the Order shall henceforth be considered a public filing.
