ORDER FOR DETENTION ON REMAND

The Accused:

Ljubiša Petković

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Order in lieu of indictment in the case No. IT-03-67-R77.1, issued confidentially by the Trial Chamber on 13 May 2008;

NOTING that Ljubiša Petković was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 28 May 2008;

NOTING the Order issued on 23 May 2008 by the Vice-President of the Tribunal, acting on behalf of the President of the Tribunal, assigning the case against Ljubiša Petković (“Accused”) to Trial Chamber III;

NOTING the Order issued by the Trial Chamber on 28 May 2008 lifting the confidentiality of the proceedings against Ljubiša Petković;

PURSUANT TO Rule 64 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;


HEREBY ORDERS the detention on remand of the Accused and enjoins the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
