TRIAL CHAMBER III (“Trial Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING that the Pre-Trial Conference in this case is scheduled to be held on Wednesday, 9 July 2008;

RECALLING that pursuant to Rule 84 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) each Party may make an opening statement before the presentation of evidence by the Prosecution but that the Defence can elect to make its opening statement at the end of the Prosecution’s case and before the commencement of its case;

RECALLING that the trial shall commence immediately upon the completion of the Pre-Trial Conference with the opening statement of the Prosecution;

HEREBY ORDERS that the delivery of the Prosecution opening statement is not to exceed two hours.
