**I, FAUSTO POCAR,** President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia Since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

**NOTING** the "Order Designating the State in which Hazim Delić is to Serve his Sentence", filed on 29 April 2003, in which the President of the International Tribunal designates Finland as the State in which Hazim Delić is to serve his sentence ("Order");

**CONSIDERING** that Hazim Delić was subsequently transferred to Finland and has since been released;

**FINDING** therefore that the reason for issuing the Order on a confidential basis is no longer applicable;

**HEREBY INSTRUCT** the Registry of the International Tribunal to lift the confidential status of the Order, and **ORDER** that the Order shall henceforth be considered a public filing.
