TRIAL CHAMBER I (“Chamber”) of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the Chamber’s Decision on Mr Čermak’s Motion for Provisional Release, filed confidentially on 18 July 2008 (“Decision”);¹

NOTING Ivan Čermak’s Notice Concerning the Confidential Decision of the Trial Chamber of 18 July 2008 Granting Ivan Čermak Provisional Release, filed on 31 July 2008 (“Notice”);

CONSIDERING that the Decision was filed confidentially in order to preserve the private nature of the provisional release of Mr Čermak;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber has recently received information that news of Mr Čermak’s provisional release has entered the public domain;

CONSIDERING that the Čermak Defence has no objection to lifting the confidential status of the Decision;²


CONSIDERING that, under these circumstances, retaining the confidential status of the Decision would not serve the purpose for which confidentiality was originally ordered;

FINDS no other reason why the Decision should remain confidential;

PURSUANT to Rule 54 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

REQUESTS the Registry to lift the confidential status of the Decision.
