I, ALPHONS ORIE, Judge in a Specially Appointed Chamber ("Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

NOTING the Order in Lieu of Indictment of 27 August 2008 ("Order");

NOTING that **FLORENCE HARTMANN** ("Accused"), in the Order, was summoned to appear before the Chamber at 15.00 hours on 15 September 2008 in Courtroom I;

CONSIDERING Rule 62 (A) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") which provides that an accused shall be brought before the Trial Chamber to which the case is assigned or a Judge thereof without delay, and shall be formally charged;

CONSIDERING the submission by the Accused, filed on 10 September 2008, in which she sets out the professional obligations she currently has with the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe which make her unable to travel to the Hague for the scheduled initial appearance on 15 September 2008;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 62 (A) of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULE the initial appearance of the Accused for 13 October 2008 at 14.15 in Courtroom III.
