1. In the Motion, the Pavković Defence requests the Trial Chamber to order the Registry to provide him with a medical report on his health, specifically on four issues detailed in annex A to the Motion.

2. The Chamber considers that it would be appropriate for the Registry to provide a medical report including the information requested in annex A.

3. Accordingly, the Trial Chamber, pursuant to Rules 33(B), 54, and 74 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal, hereby DIRECTS the Registry of the Tribunal to submit, by no later than Monday, 17 November 2008, a report providing the information requested in annex A to the Motion

4. The Pavković Defence, in accordance with Rule 34 of the Rules Governing the Detention of Persons Awaiting Trial or Appeal Before the Tribunal or Otherwise Detained on the Authority of the Tribunal, is hereby REQUESTED to (a) consult the Accused in order to obtain his signed consent for the above information to be released to the Registry and Chamber and (b) file such consent on the official record of the proceedings.
