I, Iain Bonomy, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

BEING SEISED of a “Motion for Adequate Facilities and Equality of Arms: Legal Associates” filed by the Accused on 25 November 2008 (“Motion”),


CONSIDERING that it would be in the interests of good case management to require expedited responses to the Motion,
