I, Iain Bonomy, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for

Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former

Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of a "Motion for Disclosure of Rule 68 Material Obtained under Rule 70(B)" filed by

the Accused on 4 December 2008 ("Motion"),
