**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**BEING SEISED OF** the “Prosecution Request for Leave to Reply to the ‘Response to the Motion to Amend the Indictment’”, filed publicly on 30 January 2009 (“Request”);

**CONSIDERING** that, in the Request, the Prosecution applies pursuant to Rule 126 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”) for leave to reply to the Accused’s “Response to the Motion to Amend the Indictment”, filed on 28 January 2009 (“Response”);

**NOTING** the Prosecution’s submission that it seeks to reply to elements of the Accused’s Response and address the application of Rule 50 of the Rules;


**NOTING** the Prosecution’s undertaking that the reply would be filed no later than 4 February 2009;

**PURSUANT TO** Rule 126 *bis* of the Rules;

**HEREBY:**

- (a) **GRANTS** the Prosecution leave to reply to the Response; and
- (b) **ORDERS** that the reply be filed no later than 4 February 2009.
