I, Iain Bonomy, Judge of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for

Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former

Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of the "Request for judicial review of the Registry decision on the assignment of Mr.

Marko Sladojević as Legal Associate", filed by the Accused on 24 March 2009 ("Request"),

NOTING that the Prosecution has indicated that it does not intend to respond to the Request,

CONSIDERING that it would be of assistance to the Trial Chamber for the Registry to make a

submission in response to the Request pursuant to Rule 33(B) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and

Evidence ("Rules"), and for the Registry to set out its position as to whether there remains the

possibility of a conflict of interest should Mr. Sladojević be assigned as a legal associate to the

Accused, in light of the recent rendering of the Appeals Judgement in the Krajišnik case.

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 65 ter(B) of the Rules,

HEREBY INVITE the Registry to file any submission it wishes the Trial Chamber to consider in

response to the Request, pursuant to Rule 33 (B) of the Rules, no later than Friday 27 March 2009.
