NOTING that the last Status Conference in this case was held on 2 April 2009;


NOTING that at the last Status Conference it was indicated that the next one would take place on or around 6 May 2009;

HEREBY SCHEDULE a Status Conference for Wednesday, 6 May 2009 at 2.15 p.m. in Courtroom 1.
