

**NOTING** the “Memorandum of Service”, filed confidentially on 7 July 2009, in which Mr. Milošević is reported to be willing to come to testify before the Tribunal;

**CONSIDERING** that the Victims and Witnesses Section of the Tribunal has informed the Trial Chamber that arrangements cannot be made for Mr. Milošević to arrive at the Tribunal in time to give testimony on 9 July 2009;

**HEREBY SCHEDULES** the testimony of Mr. Milošević to be heard at 2.15 p.m. on Wednesday 15 July 2009 in Courtroom 3.
