NOTING the "Decision on Accused's Application for Certification to Appeal Decision on

Holbrooke Agreement Motion", issued 17 July 2009;

NOTING the "Motion for Extension of Time", filed before the Appeals Chamber by Radovan

Karadžić on 24 July 2009, in which Radovan Karadžić ("Accused") requests an extension of time

until 17 August 2009 to file his appeal to the Holbrooke Decision;

NOTING that President Patrick Robinson is currently absent from the International Tribunal and

that, pursuant to Rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal

("Rules"), the Vice-President shall exercise the functions of the President in case of the latter's

absence or inability to act;

CONSIDERING that the Accused is requesting an extension of time on the very day that the time

for his filing of an appeal expires;

CONSIDERING that the Prosecution has not yet had an opportunity to respond to the Motion and

that the judicial recess commences at the close of business today;

PURSUANT TO Rules 19, 21, and 28 of the Rules;

HEREBY REQUEST the Registry to transmit the Motion to the Duty Judge in order for him to

consider whether the matter falls under his prerogatives.
