THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of the Accused's "Motion for binding Order: Government of Italy", filed publicly

on 4 August 2009 ("Motion"), whereby the Accused requests the Trial Chamber to issue a binding

providing a response to the Accused's Motion within 14 days from this Invitation, by

close of business on 19 August 2009; and

(b) **REQUESTS** the Registry to provide both the Motion and this Invitation to the

Government of the Italian Republic.
