THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED of the Accused's "Motion for binding Order: Government of France", filed

publicly on 24 August 2009 ("Motion"), whereby the Accused requests the Trial Chamber to issue a

binding order pursuant to Rule 54 bis of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal

("Rules") requiring the Government of France to produce a number of documents;<sup>1</sup>

business on 8 September 2009; and

(b) **REQUESTS** the Registry to provide both the Motion and this Invitation to the

Government of France.
