I, PATRICK ROBINSON, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“International Tribunal”),

NOTING the “Order Regarding Composition of Trial Chamber”, issued 1 June 2007, ordering that Judge O-Gon Kwon shall be assigned to the Bench in *Prosecutor v. Zdravko Tolimir*, Case No. IT-05-88/2;

NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorizes the President of the International Tribunal to coordinate the work of the Chambers;


