I, KEVIN PARKER, Presiding Judge of Trial Chamber II of the International Tribunal for the

Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law

Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("International Tribunal"),

NOTING the "Order regarding Composition of Trial Chamber", issued by Judge Carmel Agius on

1 June 2007, in which he ordered that that the bench in the case of *Prosecutor v. Zdravko Tolimir*

shall be composed of himself as Presiding Judge, Judge O-Gon Kwon and Judge Kimberly Prost;

NOTING the composition of the trial chambers of the International Tribunal, as set out in

document IT/266 issued by the President of the International Tribunal ("President") on 2 September

2009, in which he, inter alia, reassigned Judge O-Gon Kwon to Trial Chamber III and reassigned

Judge Christoph Flügge to Trial Chamber II;

NOTING the "Order Regarding Assignment of a Judge to a Trial Chamber", issued by the

President on 2 September 2009, in which he ordered that Judge O-Gon Kwon remain a Judge of

Trial Chamber II for the purposes of *Prosecutor v. Zdravko Tolimir*, pending any further order;

CONSIDERING the trial management and case distribution needs of the Trial Chamber;

PURSUANT TO Article 14(7) of the Statute of the Tribunal,

HEREBY ASSIGN, with immediate effect, Judge Christoph Flügge to replace Judge O-Gon Kwon

on the bench in the case of *Prosecutor v. Zdravko Tolimir*.
