

THE APPEALS CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory

of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Appeals Chamber" and "Tribunal," respectively),

BEING SEISED of a "Motion to Replace Prosecution's Response to Article 19 Amicus Brief with

Revised Response", filed by the Amicus Curiae Prosecutor on 8 March 2010 ("Motion"), requesting

leave to file a revised response to Article 19's Amicus Curiae Brief;

CONSIDERING that the Amicus Curiae Prosecutor submits that (1) the originally filed response

exceeded the word limit due to an error in the word count calculation and that this has now been

corrected; (2) certain clerical errors, such as the omission of paragraph numbers, have been

corrected; and (3) no substantive arguments have been added to the revised response;¹
