I, LIU DAQUN, Judge of the Appeals Chamber of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of

Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the

Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"), and Pre-Appeal Judge in this case, 1

NOTING the Judgement rendered in the case Prosecutor v. Milan Milutinović et al., Case No. IT-

05-87-T, by Trial Chamber III on 26 February 2009 ("Trial Judgement");

CONSIDERING that, pursuant to Rule 65bis (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the

Tribunal ("Rules") a status conference should be convened within one hundred and twenty days of

the filing of a notice of appeal and thereafter within one hundred and twenty days after the last

status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in

relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

NOTING that Nikola Šainović, Dragoljub Ojdanić, Nebojša Pavković, Vladimir Lazarević and

Sreten Lukić are currently in custody at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending

the resolution of the appeals filed against the Trial Judgement;

**NOTING** that the last status conference in this case was held on 18 January 2010;

**PURSUANT** to Rule 65bis(B) of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDER that a status conference shall be held before me on Tuesday, 18 May 2010 at a

time and in a courtroom to be announced by the Registry of the Tribunal.
