THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons

Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the

Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

BEING SEISED OF the Accused's "Motion for Binding Order: Government of Venezuela",

filed on 1 November 2010 ("Motion"), whereby the Accused requests the Trial Chamber to

issue a binding order pursuant to Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 bis of the

Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal ("Rules") requiring the Government of the

Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela ("Venezuela") to provide certain documents to him;¹

NOTING that in the Motion the Accused indicates that he sent a letter to Venezuela requesting

these documents on 19 October 2010, but submits that he received no response and thus decided

to file the Motion.²

NOTING further that the Accused submits that justice would better be served by giving

Venezuela the opportunity to be heard before the Motion is decided, and that he requests that the

Chamber issue an invitation to Venezuela to respond to the Motion;³

CONSIDERING that, in order to determine the Motion, the Trial Chamber would be assisted

by hearing from Venezuela;

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 of the Rules,

HEREBY:

(a) INVITES Venezuela to assist the Trial Chamber by filing a response to the

Motion within 14 days of this Invitation, by close of business on 16 November

2010; and
