NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal authorises the President to coordinate the work of the Chambers;

CONSIDERING the composition of the Trial Chambers of the International Tribunal as set out in document IT/266 issued on 2 September 2009;

CONSIDERING the trial management and case distribution needs of the International Tribunal;

HEREBY ASSIGN Judge Howard Morrison to replace Judge Kevin Parker on the bench seised of this case.
