ORDERS that the arguments to be presented pursuant to Rule 98 bis take place in

Courtroom III, at 1415 hours on 7 March 2011, at 1430 hours on 8 March 2011

and, if so required, at 1430 hours on 9 March 2011, the Accused having 3.5 hours

to present his arguments, and once the Accused has completed his submission, the

Prosecution will have 4 hours to respond and the Accused will then have 30 minutes

to reply.
