ORDER TO VACATE THE ORDER IN LIEU OF INDICTMENT

THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

NOTING the Order in Lieu of Indictment in the *Contempt Case of Berko Zečević*, issued by the Chamber on 4 February 2011 (“Order in Lieu of Indictment”);¹

NOTING the Decision on Motion for Withdrawal of Order Lieu of Indictment, issued by the Chamber on 18 February 2011, suspending the Order in Lieu of Indictment and the Order for Detention on Remand dated 17 February 2011, until further order;²


NOTING that Berko Zečević completed his testimony in the case of *Prosecutor v. Karadžić*, Case No. IT-95-5/18-T, on 24 February 2011;

CONSIDERING that it is not in the interests of justice to continue with contempt proceedings against Berko Zečević;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

HEREBY VACATES the Order in Lieu of Indictment and the Order for Detention on Remand dated 17 February 2011.
