NOTING that Milan Lukić and Sredoje Lukić are currently in detention at the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague pending appeal;


NOTING that the last status conference took place on 11 November 2010;

CONSIDERING that, pursuant to Rule 65*bis* (B) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the International Tribunal, a status conference should be convened within one hundred and twenty days after the last status conference, to allow any person in custody pending appeal the opportunity to raise issues in relation thereto, including the mental and physical condition of that person;

HEREBY ORDER that a status conference shall be held in Courtroom 3 on 10 March 2011 at 15:00.
