THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Public Edited Version of ‘Decision on Failure to Remove Confidential Information from Public Website and Order in Lieu of Indictment Issued on 9 May 2011’” of 24 May 2011, wherein the Trial Chamber initiated contempt proceedings against Vojislav Šešelj (“Accused”) by charging him with one count of contempt of the Tribunal, punishable under Rule 77(A) and 77(A)(ii) of the Rules, for knowingly and wilfully failing to comply with a Chamber’s orders to remove confidential information from his website;

NOTING Rule 62 (A) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (“Rules”), which provides that an accused shall be brought before the Trial Chamber to which the case is assigned without delay, and shall be formally charged;

PURSUANT TO Rule 62 of the Rules;

HEREBY SCHEDULES the initial appearance of the Accused for 6 July 2011 at 3.00 p.m. in Courtroom II before Judge Burton Hall.
