TRIAL CHAMBER I of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);


NOTING that **SHEFQET KABASHI** (“the Accused”) was arrested in the Kingdom of the Netherlands on 17 August 2011 and transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 18 August 2011;

CONSIDERING Rule 64 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”) which provides that an accused shall be detained upon transfer to the seat of the Tribunal;

PURSUANT TO Rules 54 and 64 of the Rules;

HEREBY ORDERS the detention on remand of the Accused and **DIRECTS** the Commanding Officer of the United Nations Detention Unit in The Hague to detain the Accused until further order.
