THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Order in Lieu of Indictment” in the Contempt Case of Dragomir Pećanac issued confidentially by the Chamber on 21 September 2011 (“Order in Lieu of Indictment”);

NOTING that Dragomir Pećanac (“Accused”) was transferred to the seat of the Tribunal on 9 October 2011;


NOTING that, in the Order in Lieu of Indictment, the Chamber decided to prosecute the matter itself;

CONSIDERING that it is in the interests of justice and of an expeditious trial to appoint a judge of the Chamber for the purpose of the initial appearance and for matters related to the transfer and detention of the Accused;

PURSUANT TO Rule 62 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal;

HEREBY DESIGNATES Judge Christoph Flügge as the Judge of this Chamber who will conduct the initial appearance of the Accused and will decide on any further issues related to the transfer and detention of the Accused.
