TRIAL CHAMBER III ("Trial Chamber") of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal");

RECALLING that on 30 September 2011 the Trial Chamber ordered that Jelena Rašić shall return to the United Nations Detention Unit by 6 January 2012, that a pre-trial conference shall be held on 9 January 2012, and that the trial shall commence following the pre-trial conference ("Order");¹

CONSIDERING that it is necessary to amend the Order in view of the scheduling of other trials to which the Judges seised of this case are assigned;

HAVING CONSULTED the parties;


PURSUANT TO Articles 20 and 29 of the Statute and Rules 54, 65 and 73 *bis* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

ORDERS that the pre-trial conference shall be held on Monday 23 January 2012 to be followed by the commencement of trial;

ORDERS Jelena Rašić to return to the United Nations Detention Unit by Friday 20 January 2012;

AFFIRMS the Order in all other respects.
