**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Tribunal"),

**NOTING** that on 30 November 2011, Milan Tupajić (the "Accused") was charged with contempt of the Tribunal pursuant to Rule 77(A) of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules") for knowingly and wilfully interfering with the administration of justice by refusing to comply with two subpoenas issued by the Chamber which ordered him to appear and testify in the case of *Prosecutor v. Radovan Karadžić* ("*Karadžić* Case");<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** that on 16 December 2011, at the initial appearance of the Accused, he maintained that he would not testify in the *Karadžić* Case and pleaded not guilty to the charge of contempt;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** that on 3 February 2012, the trial of the Accused was held in which he testified and presented evidence in his case;<sup>3</sup>

NOTING that the Chamber thereafter deliberated pursuant to Rule 87(A) of the Rules;

PURSUANT TO Rule 98 ter of the Rules;

**HEREBY SCHEDULE** the pronouncement of the Judgement for Friday, 24 February 2012, at 3:30 p.m. in Courtroom I.
