**ORDER ON THE LETTER TO THE PRESIDENT BY THE

I, THEODOR MERON, President of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

NOTING the “Information/Caution To: The President of the ICTY”, filed by Mr. Dejan Mirović, Legal Advisor to Mr. Vojislav Šešelj (“Šešelj”), on 22 February 2012 (“Letter”), which states, *inter alia*, that members of Šešelj’s defence team were not allowed a privileged visit with Šešelj on 16 and 17 February 2012;


CONSIDERING that it is in the interest of justice to permit the Registry of the Tribunal (“Registry”) to file a submission, if any, addressing the issues raised in the Letter, and to allow Šešelj the opportunity to respond to the Registry’s submission;

HEREBY ORDER that the Registry shall have five days from the date of this Order to file a submission, if any, in response to the Letter;

AND ORDER that Šešelj shall file a response, if any, to the Registry’s submission no later than five days after the receipt of the B/C/S translation of the Registry’s submission, after which the Registry shall have three days to file a reply, if any, to Šešelj’s response.
