

CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE DECISION DENYING PROSECUTION'S MOTION TO ADMIT INTO EVIDENCE MFI P171 AND P911

NOTING that on 13 March 2012, the Trial Chamber issued its "Decision denying Prosecution's motion to admit into evidence MFI P171 and P911" in which it denied the admission into evidence of the two documents;

CONSIDERING that it has since come to the Trial Chamber's attention that the document marked for identification as P911 had previously been admitted into evidence through the testimony of witness Christian Nielsen as Exhibit P642;¹

INFORMS the parties that document P642 will remain in evidence, whereas P911 MFI will be marked as not admitted in eCourt;

ORDERS the Registry to take the necessary steps to implement this Clarification.
