**THIS TRIAL CHAMBER** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”);

**NOTING** that on 18 March 2010, PW-017 testified pursuant to Rule 92 *bis*(C);


**NOTING** that it came to the Chamber’s attention that only a confidential version of PW-017’s prior testimony in the *Krstić* case was tendered and admitted into evidence<sup>1</sup> and that it is therefore necessary to have its public version of the transcript on the record;

**NOTING** that the Accused informed the Chamber through his legal advisor that he had no objection to the admission of the public version;<sup>2</sup>

**HEREBY** orders as follows:

- (1) the public version of PW-017’s prior testimony in the *Krstić* case shall be admitted into evidence; and
- (2) the Registry assign it an exhibit number.
