NOTING that Rule 19 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal authorises the President to coordinate the work of the Chambers;


CONSIDERING the current composition of the Trial Chambers of the Tribunal, as set out in IT/272, issued on 28 February 2011;
