THIS TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”),

CONSIDERING the “Decision on Second Motion for Subpoena: Edin Garaplija” issued on 18 December 2012, in which the Chamber granted the Accused’s motion filed on 3 December 2012 requesting that a subpoena be issued directing witness Edin Garaplija to appear before the Chamber to give oral testimony on 6 February 2013;

PURSUANT TO Article 29 of the Statute of the Tribunal and Rule 54 of the Tribunal’s Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”);


HEREBY ORDERS EDIN GARAPLIJA:

TO APPEAR to testify before this Trial Chamber in the case of *Prosecutor v. Karadžić* at the seat of the Tribunal at Churchillplein 1, 2517 JW, The Hague, The Netherlands on 6 February 2013, or to show good cause why this subpoena cannot be complied with. The date of Mr. Garaplija’s testimony is subject to change, and this subpoena remains in force notwithstanding any such change. Mr. Garaplija will be notified of any change of date of, or location for, his testimony through the Registrar of the Tribunal.

FURTHER INFORMS EDIN GARAPLIJA that all necessary measures will be taken by the Victim and Witness Section of the Tribunal for his travel and appearance, and that all necessary costs incurred by virtue of his testimony shall be borne by the Tribunal. Representatives of the Tribunal and the authorities of the Bosnia and Herzegovina have been directed to take whatever steps are reasonably necessary to ensure service of this subpoena and his appearance at trial.

**WILFUL FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THIS SUBPOENA
CONSTITUTES CONTEMPT OF THE TRIBUNAL, PURSUANT TO RULE 77 OF THE
RULES, WHICH IS PUNISHABLE BY A TERM OF IMPRISONMENT NOT
EXCEEDING SEVEN YEARS, A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 100,000 EUROS, OR BOTH.**
