The Trial Chamber


ORDERS that the following blanked text be omitted from the public transcript of this hearing and be edited from the public broadcast of this hearing dated 7 February 2013.

11:53:44 THE WITNESS: [Interpretation] Yes, I do want to.

11:53:52 THE WITNESS: [Interpretation] Everything that I've ever had
11:53:58 throughout the seven years that I was in English prisons, it is known to
11:54:05 some members of the Chamber and to the public, and by the same token it

11:55:34 Detention Unit, although I'm under constant monitoring of a team of
11:55:39 psychiatrists who care for my health. My disease has not been checked,
