THE TRIAL CHAMBER of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 (“Tribunal”) issues ex-officio the present order setting a date and a time for the pronouncement of the judgement in this case.

1. The trial opened on 7 November 2007 and the Prosecution and Defence closing arguments concluded on 20 March 2012. The Trial Chamber subsequently withdrew to deliberate the judgement.
2. Pursuant to Rule 98 *ter* of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence of the Tribunal (the “Rules”), the judgement shall be pronounced in public, on a date of which the parties requested to attend shall be informed.
3. Consequently, pursuant to Rules 54, 87 and 98 *ter* of the Rules, the Trial Chamber **ORDERS** that the judgement be pronounced on Wednesday, 30 October 2013 at 0900 hours.
