## INVITATION TO PARTIES TO MAKE SUBMISSIONS IN RELATION TO THE FUTURE TRIAL SITTING SCHEDULE

**NOTING** the Appeals Chamber Decision on Mladić's Interlocutory Appeal Regarding Modification of Trial Sitting Schedule Due to Health Concerns, filed on 22 October 2013 ("Appeal Decision"), in which it ordered the Chamber to adopt a four-day sitting schedule for the remainder of the Prosecution's case against Mr Ratko Mladić, and directed it to reassess the trial sitting schedule at the beginning of the Defence case;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** its Order for Medical Examination of the Accused Pursuant to Rule 74 *bis*, filed on 15 November 2013 ("Order"), in which it instructed the Registry, for the purposes of reviewing the trial sitting schedule in compliance with the Appeal Decision, to have medical examinations of Mr Miadić conducted and to have expert reports on his medical condition compiled;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the Registry's confidential filing of 24 January 2014, submitting the medical reports in accordance with the Order ("Medical Reports");<sup>3</sup>

**NOTING** that the Defence case, if any, is tentatively scheduled to start on 13 May 2014;<sup>4</sup>

**CONSIDERING** it appropriate, in light of the Medical Reports, to give the parties an opportunity to make written submissions on the future trial sitting schedule;

**HEREBY INVITES** the parties to make written submissions in relation to the future trial sitting schedule, having regard to the Medical Reports, within two weeks of this filing.
