#### INVITATION TO THE REPUBLIC OF SERBIA

**TRIAL CHAMBER I** of the International Tribunal for the Prosecution of Persons Responsible for Serious Violations of International Humanitarian Law Committed in the Territory of the Former Yugoslavia since 1991 ("Chamber" and "Tribunal", respectively);

**BEING SEISED** of the *Amicus Curiae* Prosecutor's request, filed on 7 July 2017 ("Request"), seeking the assistance of the Chamber in obtaining full transcripts of two proceedings involving the Accused before the War Crimes Chamber in the High Court in Belgrade, which took place on 18 May 2016 ("Transcripts");<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the *Amicus Curiae* Prosecutor's submission that on 25 May and 5 June 2017 she sent correspondence to the Serbian authorities, requesting access to the Transcripts;<sup>2</sup>

**NOTING** the *Amicus Curiae* Prosecutor's submission that a representative of the High Court in Belgrade responded to her first correspondence of 25 May in relation to the formalities of such a request but did not respond to her second correspondence of 5 June;<sup>3</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that it is appropriate to give the Republic of Serbia an opportunity to make submissions on the matter before the Chamber decides on the Request;

PURSUANT TO Rule 54 bis of the Tribunal's Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

ORDERS the Registry to serve the Request on the Republic of Serbia; and

**INVITES** the Republic of Serbia to make written submissions in relation to the Request within three weeks of the filing of this invitation.
